Weather Forecast

Situation - A low pressure system is located over western Bass Strait, with an associated surface trough extending across western Victoria. The trough will move eastwards across eastern Victoria later on Thursday afternoon, while the low will be well east of Tasmania by the evening. A high pressure system well south of the Bight will drift slowly eastwards to be southwest of Bass Strait later on Friday, before drifting across Tasmania on Saturday. The high will move into the Tasman Sea on Sunday as the next front approaches southwestern Victoria late in the day.

Friday 29 Nov – Cloudy. Areas of rain, easing to isolated light showers in the morning. Winds northwest to southwesterly 20 to 30 km/h becoming southwesterly 25 to 35 km/h before dawn then tending southerly in the early afternoon.

Editor's prediction – Go to Leeton.

Saturday 30 Nov – Isolated light showers in the south early in the morning. Sunny day. Winds south to southeasterly 15 to 20 km/h becoming light during the morning.

Editor's prediction – Stay in Leeton.

Sunday 01 Dec – Mostly sunny. Light winds becoming north to northeasterly 15 to 20 km/h during the morning then becoming light during the day.

Editor's prediction – Stay in Leeton.
