Weather Forecast

Situation – A high pressure system lies over the Tasman Sea. An inland low pressure trough will extend southwards to western deepening and moving slowly eastwards on Friday. The trough will link with a cold front which is expected to cross southern Victoria on Friday afternoon. The system will move rapidly east and develop a low pressure system over the Tasman Sea on Saturday. The next high pressure system will move south of the Bight on Saturday, crossing Bass Strait early on Sunday.

Friday 24 Jan. – Cloudy. Rain developing in the morning, then clearing during the evening. The chance of thunderstorms in the morning and afternoon. Possible heavy falls. Winds north to northeasterly 20-30 km/h shifting south to southwesterly 15-25 km/h in the late morning, 24°C.

Saturday 25 Jan. – A chance of showers in the south early in the morning. Sunny day. Winds south to southwesterly 15-25 km/h, 26°C.

Sunday 26 Jan. – Sunny. Winds southerly 15 to 20 km/h becoming light during the morning, 29°C.
