Weather Forecast

Situation – A high pressure system located south of New Zealand extends a ridge across eastern Victoria. A weak cold front brushed the southwest coast today with a stronger front to rapidly cross Bight waters tonight. The front will reach western Victoria on Friday morning and move across eastern Victoria during the afternoon. The next high pressure system will cross northern Bight waters on Friday, then move over Adelaide on Saturday to reach southern NSW early Sunday. Another cold front will move across Tasmania late on Sunday with a further front approaching western Victoria late on Monday.

Friday 18 Apr. – Cloudy. Isolated showers from the early morning. Winds west to northwesterly 15 to 25 km/h turning southwesterly in the early afternoon; max. 19°C.

Saturday 19 Apr. – Partly cloudy. Winds southwesterly 15 to 20 km/h becoming light early in the morning; max. 16°C.

Sunday 20 Apr. – Partly cloudy. Winds west to northwesterly and light increasing to 15 to 20 km/h during the morning then becoming light during the day; max. 17°C.

Monday 21 Apr. – Mostly sunny. Light winds becoming northerly 15 to 25 km/h during the day; max. 17°C.
